#### **Thermometer Poster**


An Appeal thermometer poster will be sent as well. You can use this poster to track your parishes progress and show your parish goal.

# **Parish Leadership Roles**

#### **Pastor**

The Pastor provides leadership, expertise, direction and oversight to the appeal, and is essential to the success of the Appeal at the parish.

- Instruct and assure that the methods to conduct the campaign are fully implemented.
- Recruitment of an Appeal Coordinator or Committee.
- Encourage all parishioners to consider a generous gift in gratitude for all that the Lord has given them.
- Be familiar with ministries and programs that benefit from the Appeal.
- Provide a personal letter of support for the bulletin/website.
- A message of support directly from the pastor will resonate with parishioners and they will be more likely to respond.

## **Appeal Coordinator/Appeal Committee**

- Introduce and endorse the video message during Kick-off Weekend or Education Weekend.
- Give pulpit presentations at each weekend Mass.
- Consider a phone campaign to reach out to all parishioners with an encouraging message.
- Encourage the use of the response envelopes and other ways to give.
- Be familiar with ministries and programs that benefit from the Appeal and be prepared to answer questions from parishioners.
- Provide timely updates during the active phase of the Appeal from the pulpit.

#### **Parish Administrative Assistant**

- Assist the pastor/appeal committee with rollout and appeal timetable.
- Making sure the Appeal video is available to parishioners.
- Have the brochures available for parishioners and the poster in a high traffic area.
- Encourage parishioners to participate in the Appeal.
- Put weekly messages in the bulletin with the progress of your parish.

# **Areas of Support**

## **Appeal goal = \$850,000**

All appeal funds are used to support the following areas:

## Seminary/Clergy support \$200,000

Your commitment to the Bishop's Annual Appeal helps to ensure the formation of the next generation of priests and leaders of our Diocese. The Appeal funds support vocations, continuing education & spiritual direction for priests as well as financial assistance for retired priests.

#### Local Missions \$295,000

Assisting our Missions brings the joy of the Gospel to our brothers and sisters in some of the most remote places on Vancouver Island. Operational expenses for these Missions, maintenance and compensation for Clergy & Sisters are a few expenses the Appeal helps to fund.

## Community & Relationship Building \$185,000

Communicating effectively is at the heart of evangelization and faith formation in our Catholic faith. Your gift gives the promise that a deep understanding of our faith is passed on to future generations and to all those seeking Christ. The Diocese promotes clear communications, and the training and formation of catechetical leaders to foster those who will one day be initiated into the life of our Church. The Community & Relationship program will continue where parishes and schools can apply for a grant to build community & relationships at a local level. These projects are for community outreach, parish celebrations and special projects.

## Parish Portion \$170,000

Each parish uses their funds towards a project that is chosen by their pastor and parish leadership. These projects vary from parish to parish but are a meaningful way for each faith community to come together and share a common goal that will enrich their Christian unity.

#### **Administrative Costs**

This year all administrative costs for the Bishop's Appeal will be covered by the Diocese of Victoria.

The parish sharing formula has not changed and continues with:

- Every dollar raised **up to** the goal 20% is for the parish project.
- Every dollar raised **above** the goal 80% is for the parish project.
- Every dollar raised **beyond** 200% of the goal 100% is for the parish project.

#### October

#### **November**

"Encore"

- Continue pulpit announcements
- Continue to promote the Diocesan website for donations
- Update parishioners with weekly progress reports from pulpit, in bulletin and on-line

#### **December**

- The active phase is over, but pledges and donations are still being accepted
- Reinforce that any donations received before December 31st will receive an income tax receipt for 2024.
- Keep striving to reach the parish goal

# **Key Strategies / Messaging**

#### For the Pastor, Parish Pastoral Council and Appeal Team.

- a. Select a compelling tangible parish project or a specific need.
- b. Report on what was done with last year's Parish Portion of the Appeal.
- c. Consider the Outreach Registry—if your parish doesn't have a specific need.
- d. Emphasize the theme: Sharing God's Gifts.
- e. Look to the Holy Spirit for peace, comfort and guidance.
- f. Have commitments and pledges from the Pastor, the Appeal Team and key parish leadership in place prior to the kickoff of the campaign.
- g. Advertise on kickoff weekend that you have already reached \_\_\_\_\_% of your goal with pledges of \$\_\_\_\_\_.
- h. Use the thermometer to track progress, if appropriate.
- i. Arrange compelling, parish-centered presentations by the Pastor and/or Appeal lay leaders, with emphasis on your Parish Project, for each of the three weeks.
- j. On Kickoff Week introduce your parish project and encourage giving!

# **Frequently Asked Questions**

# How are parish goals determined?

Parish goals are determined using a five-year average of parish collections, pro-rated across the total overall Appeal Goal.

# What is the sharing formula between the Parish and the Diocese?

- Every dollar raised **up to** the goal 20% is for the parish project.
- Every dollar raised **above** the goal 80% is for the parish project.
- Every dollar raised **beyond** 200% of the goal 100% is for the parish project.

# Why does it make sense to donate to the Appeal rather than directly to my Parish?

Supporting the Bishop's Appeal is supporting all our brothers and sisters on Vancouver Island. Whether it is a young man entering the priesthood or a retired Diocesan priest, a Mission church or supporting a parish initiative.
