Kickoff Weekend – October 4-5

This weekend we begin the 2025 Bishop's Appeal, with the theme Love and Unity. Pope Leo said, "I would like that our first great desire be for a united Church, a sign of unity and communion, which becomes a leaven for a reconciled world." These words inspire us to come together as one family of faith, supporting one another in love and generosity.

The Bishop's Appeal is more than a fundraising effort, it is a way for us to live out our call to be the Body of Christ. This year, the Appeal will support vocations, ensuring the formation and growth of future priests and pastoral leaders, while also caring for the retired clergy who have served so faithfully.
