Code of Conduct

- 1. All sessions must be attended by youth, leaders, and chaperones
- All chaperones must stay with their groups at all times during the conference. When the
 youth are divided for Saturday's Retreat/Camp Activities, divide up your chaperones
 as well.
- 3. There will be mandatory Chaperone Meetings on Friday 4:45-5:00PM and Saturday 7:00-7:30PM. All youth leaders and chaperones are asked to attend. Meetings are in the Music Room.
- 4. No participant may leave the conference or billet site unless accompanied by a youth leader or chaperone
- 5. Cell phones and all devices will be collected at the start of the retreat and returned at the end.
- 6. Participants must show respect for others and their property at all times.
- 7. A participant will be dismissed from the Home Retreat if they are:
 - a. Under the influence, or is in possession of drugs or alcohol.
 - b. In the presence of another who is under the influence, or who is clearly in possession of drugs or alcohol.
 - c. Behaving abnormally or inappropriately.
- 8. If out of town participants are dismissed, it is the responsibility of their Parish Leader or Chaperone to deal with the situation. Any costs incurred from dismissal will be the responsibility of the participant's family.

Dress Code:

- 1. Clothing that permits, advertises, or refers to the following is not permitted:
 - a. Derogatory racial, religious, or sexist messages.
 - b. Vulgar, abusive, and inappropriate language.
 - c. Illegal activity.
 - d. Drugs, alcohol, or tobacco.
- 2. No revealing clothing such as halter tops, backless shirts, bare midriffs, spaghetti straps, and see-through clothing are to be worn during the Retreat. Clothing must cover the entire back, front, shoulder, and mid-section at all times.

3.	No undergarments are to be visible at any time and no pajamas are to be worn outside of sleeping areas.

Expectations for Youth

- Encourage good manner and respectful behaviour
- No foul language, inappropriate jokes, or derogatory comments.
- Shoulders, midriff, and above the knees should be covered. Please dress warmly when going outside.
- No coffee or tea for youth
- No food or drink in rooms
- Students are expected to take part in ALL retreat and Homewood activities
- Cell phones and other media devices will be collected at the beginning of the retreat and returned at the end.
- Students are not permitted to be in their rooms during retreat and Camp activities
- Pajamas are not to be worn outside of assigned rooms
- Boys may not visit in the girls' rooms and buildings, etc.
- Girls may not visit in the boys' rooms and buildings, etc.
- Rooms are to be cleaned and packed up before our 8:00AM start on Sunday
- Tie off garbage and place outside rooms on Sunday
- Take turns and share the pingpong table see Omar or Glenn for extra pingpong balls.

- Do not rearrange furniture without prior permission from Homewood staff.
