Epiphany

Epiphany is a feast from the Eastern Churches and the original Eastern celebration of Christ's birth. It now commemorates the “manifestation” of Christ to the nations and is kept on January 6th or the Sunday after January 1st.

The liturgical texts center on the magi, but include as well references to Jesus' baptism and his first miracle at Cana as images of his appearance to the world.


